Wash, clean and maintain an adequate supply of golf carts for issue and put away. Maintain an adequate supply of clean range balls by picking, washing and keeping the ball machine full. Keep range area neat and orderly. Assist all golfers with loading their golf bags on golf carts and assisting them with any of their needs. At the conclusion of their round, wash players clubs and assist them with loading bags into their cars. Keep all areas, cart barn, staging area and driving range neat and orderly throughout each day. Valid Washington State Driver's license.

3. Shuttle players to and from the resort
4. Assist where needed in any other area of the golf operation
