BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the supervision of the Resort/Grounds Const. Mgr., Golf Course Superintendent or Assistant, the Irrigation Technician is responsible for the programming, operation and maintenance of the golf course irrigation system.

QUALIFICATIONS: EDUCATION, KNOWLEDGE, TRAINING, & WORK EXPERIENCE

High School education or equivalent. Some educational background in hydraulics and basic electricity.

One year of experience as landscape irrigation assistant preferred.

Requires a working knowledge of basic electricity and hydraulics related to an irrigation system, including automatic valves and controllers, pumps and pumping systems. Mechanical aptitude a must, as well as, good communication skills.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Operates and monitors automatic irrigation system for proper course watering.
- Programs central and satellite controllers to correspond with weather conditions.
- Repairs and maintains all sprinkler heads, valves, control boxes, piping, wiring, and pumps.
- Operates power saws for pipe cutting.
- Cleans in-line screens and strainers and performs routine maintenance to pressure valves.
- Shovels by hand around broken lines and heads to properly perform repair work.
- Operates backhoe for excavating large areas for repair work.
- Edges sprinkler heads and valve boxes routinely for a clean manicured look.
- Orders needed irrigation materials within budget for repairs and upkeep of inventory.
- Records and maps all repairs and changes made to the system.
- Reports any irregularities in course turf quality to the Superintendent or Assistant.
- Operates and maintains assigned vehicle in accordance with Equipment Manager's standards.
- Organizes and keeps inventory of irrigation parts room.

MARGINAL FUNCTIONS:

Uphold the company's Mission/Vision/Values.

ENVIRONMENT:

- Works in all climate conditions and must wear all protective gear provided when operating power equipment.
- Works in confined areas below ground surface.
- Works weekends, holidays, mornings or evenings as assigned.
- Long hours, including overtime, sometimes required on major irrigation repairs to prevent turf loss.
