

We are excited to announce that the Governor has issued a new order that allows golf course to re-open with restrictions. Based on that, we will re-open our course Tuesday, May 5th. We thank you for all your support and kind words the last 30 plus days.

Please note that the following guidelines/restrictions will be in place based on the Governors order and our own guidelines. These restrictions and guidelines may change weekly.

ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS ARE REQUIRED ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDLINES

- Only two players from separate households per a tee time.
- Social distancing must be practiced with a minimum separation of six feet at all times
- Carts will be restricted to 1 rider unless minor is playing
- There will be no cups on the putting green
- Driving range and putting green will be restricted to those with a tee time within 30 minutes
- The range will be set up to accommodate social distancing
- Bunker rakes, benches, ball washers and garbage cans on the course have been removed
- Golfers are required to dispose of their own garbage when leaving the course
- Golfers are asked to leave the golf course immediately after playing to eliminate congestion/gathering on the property or in the parking lot

BOOKING TEE TIMES

We are required to maintain a log of all customers, including contact information that is on the course

- Tee times are required-there will be NO walk up times
- Tee times can be booked 1 week out on Golfnow
